Emergency Shelter / Self-Refer / No Fees

Single Women's Shelter | The Salvation Army | 630 E Washington Ave, Madison, WI 53703

Description: Night-time, drop-in shelter; first-come, first-served basis.

Services Include: dinner (typically 5PM), evening snack, breakfast, showers, laundry, and case management.
Nightly bed sign-in at 6:30pm.
